

Sign Rules apply to ALL CANDIDATES and CAMPAIGNS. No exceptions.

SIGNAGE DO's and DON'Ts are as follows.

### **DO's**

- The political sign must have a candidate's first or last name on it.
- Painter's tape must be used to attach signs.
- Campaigns must also follow any other posted rules concerning signs in the school's auditorium.
- Incumbent State Senator and State House of Representatives for Senate District 63 will have an assigned area in the auditorium.
- All other campaigns will need to compete for wall space in the auditorium.
- Campaigns may have campaign signs behind their rented table space only; signs must fit within the width of the table.
- Campaigns may have one (1) lawn sign (3 feet by 2 feet) in front of South High School on the day of the convention.
- Signs are allowed on the side walls of auditorium only.
- Signs are allowed on the balcony in the Commons Area.
- All campaigns, candidates, and groups are responsible for removing all signage and literature and returning the space(s) to the original state they found the space(s).

### **DON'Ts**

- No signs may be hung on the front wall of the auditorium.
- No campaign signs may be hung on pillars, the stage, or the front of the balcony.
- No signs may be placed on any doors.
- No free standing signs.
- No campaign literature or handouts may be placed on seats, arm rests, or taped to the backs of chairs in the auditorium prior to the start of the convention.
- No other signs are allowed on the walls in the hallways.
- Do not disturb or move any school signs, student signs, any writing on white boards in rooms
- Signs will not be allowed anywhere else on the campus. No exceptions.

Tables may be rented from Senate District 63 DFL. The \$25 fee must be paid before a table to campaign is assigned.

Classrooms may be rented from Senate District 63 DFL. A limited number of rooms are available to campaigns. The \$50 fee must be paid before a room is assigned.

Campaigns may arrive at 9:15 AM on Saturday, April 9 for setup. Campaigns will not be allowed into South High School until 9:15 AM. (Arrangements Committee agreed to assign at least one committee member and/or volunteer at the front door.) The "Sign War" in the auditorium will begin a 9:20 AM on March24. Tables and rooms may be assigned and set up at that time provided the Arrangement Committee has completed setup. Campaigns are asked to not impede with Arrangement Committee setup.

Ruling on questionable signs will be made by the chair of the Arrangement Committee, Chris Ross. All rulings are final. Non-compliance with the final ruling could cause ALL signs in the area to be removed.
